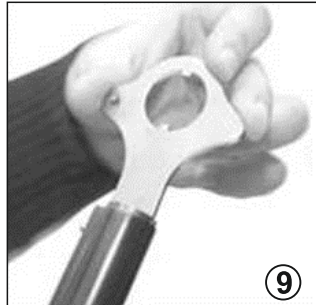
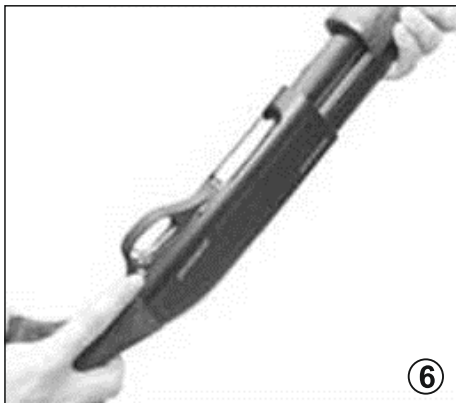
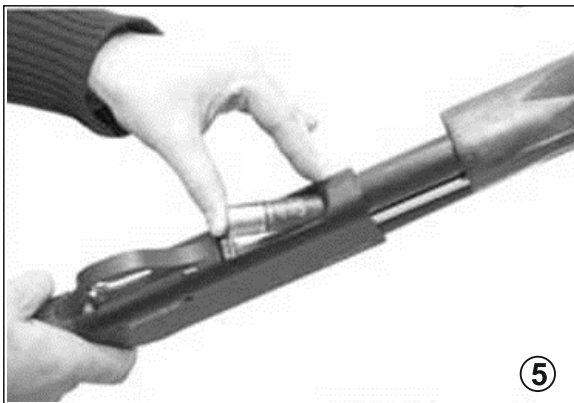
Congratulations! You have one of our high quality guns.

This instruction manual should always accompany the shotgun and be transferred with it in the event of change of ownership. Become thoroughly knowledgeable with the instructions contained herein and carefully review the entire booklet each time you intend to use your shotgun. As a responsible firearms owner, you must read this **OWNER'S MANUAL** thoroughly and become completely comfortable with it before you handle your new shotgun.

## **General safety Considerations.**

- Be absolutely certain you have ammunition correctly matched to the gun. The gauge markings on the barrel and the gauge markings on the cartridge case head must be identical. **If they are not, or you are unsure, STOP, check and if you can't be sure DON'T USE IT.** Use only ammunition of which you are certain, if you are still unsure, call us.
- Use only new, clean and bright ammunition with correct gauge
- Never use re-loads. Use of re-loaded ammunition is risky, possibly dangerous and avoids any service obligation that we provide because there is no formal quality control of the re-loaded shell.
- Shotshells are, by their nature, very powerful and particularly so, the 12 Gauge. Therefore before you shoot, you must know where your shot-load will go. Whether you hit your target or miss, it doesn't matter. You still must know where it might go.
- Before loading your shotgun, be certain the barrel is clean and unobstructed. **If it is obstructed in any way, even with excessive grease or oil, clean it out. Don't think you can shoot it out, because you can't do what you want to do, you will ruin a perfectly good barrel and that's expensive (and dangerous to you and others around you)**
- Shoot only when you are bright, alert and fit. **If you are tired, sleepy, boozed or distracted, you will not perform up to the standards of your shotgun, forget shooting and try another day.**
- Don't forget to use shooting glasses and hearing guards
- Don't be in a hurry
- Remember, shooting is a sporting endeavor, so have fun.





## **Basic initial operating instructions.**

- Your shotgun is shipped from the factory after all required function and appearance tests are completed. It comes to you with the barrel disassembled from the receiver. Assembling this gun is not suggested until you have finished reading this manual.
- Remove each segment of the shotgun from its box and clean each part.
- Look through the barrel, it must be bright and clean. Clean the barrel with a lightly oiled cloth through the barrel ensuring that there is nothing in the barrel but a bright shiny bore!
- Keep it that way and it will last a lifetime.
- Next, examine the receiver and magazine tube cap by unscrewing the cap counterclockwise
- This will fully expose the magazine tube and permit the barrel installation. Make sure it is clean and free of any loose packing materials. Lightly oil the entire assembly. Even though it has chrome - lined dual action - bars, it is steel - moving - on steel - so it needs lubrication.
- You can now install the barrel; first ensure that the magazine tube is empty. Do so by looking under the receiver, press the shell lifter and make sure that you can see the shell follower. If you can see it, it is OK, you know it is empty.
- The bolt must be in the forward or closed position. Grasp the barrel in your left hand while holding the stock / receiver assembly in your right hand. Straddle the same time lead the barrel extension into the front of the receiver in line with the bolt assembly.
- Make sure the barrel is fully seated in the receiver, you can confirm it by seeing that all of the threads of the magazine tube are fully exposed.
- Holding the barrel fully seated, install the magazine tube cap and make sure that it is fully seated. Make sure the cap is seated snugly using only hand pressure.

## **Safety Mechanism**

The primary safety mechanism is you, the owner. This is your shotgun and you are responsible for it. We made the best that modern computer technology and materials allowed. We deliver it to you and in doing so we transfer responsibility for it to you, the owner.

Notice that the trigger guard has a trigger - blocking safety button located at the rear of the trigger guard. It can only be moved to the left or right and only a small movement is needed to move it in either direction. When the red band is exposed (on the left side) it means that the safety is OFF and the shotgun is ready to fire. When the red band is completely hidden, it means that your shotgun is on safe and trigger will not function. That's all it means. You must still control the shotgun at all times and control the director that the muzzle is pointed at all times.

## **Loading**

- Your shotgun should be loaded when the bolt is closed. First make sure that the chamber is empty as well as magazine tube. Next make sure that your shotgun is on SAFE.
- Notice the bolt release lever on the lower front left hand side of trigger guard. This lever is the bolt release - mechanism controller. It serves the primary purpose of unlocking the bolt when it is fully closed if you choose to open the bolt without pulling the trigger.
- Next, turn your shotgun upside down and hold it in your left hand. You can then load as many shotshells into magazine tube as you choose or until it is full.
- The shotgun chambered for 3" magnum shotshells. It can accept 2 shotshells as well. It even accept 2\_ '\*' and 3" shotshells interchangeably! Your shotgun comes with a magazine tube plug that you install if you choose to go hunting for migratory birds. It is easy to do. Simply unscrew the magazine tube cap and install the plastic rod in the exposed center hole in the end of the magazine tube. It will go in only one way. Then re-install the cap. Nothing more to it.
- With the magazine loaded (the bolt is still closed) turn the shotgun upright and pull the forend fully rearward as far as it will go. Move the forend forward smartly and you will automatically load a shotshell into the chamber.
- You now have a loaded shotgun.
- Before shooting at anything you must know where your shoot will go. even if you miss your target, you must know there is no excuse for not knowing.

## **Unloading**

- Keep the shotgun on safe, keep the shotgun pointed down range.
- Fully depress the bolt release lever. Cycle the action by depressing the bolt release lever (thereby unlocking the bolt) and pull the forend smartly rearward. This will eject the shell from the chamber. Cycle for as many times as it takes to fully unload the magazine tube and chamber.
- When empty, the bolt must be fully back. Just look in the chamber to make sure that it is empty and look in ejector port to sec that there is not shell lying on the lifter. Keep the safety on and your finger out of the trigger guard.

## **Care and Maintenance**

- Your shotgun is easy to maintain. It needs cleaning and light oil after each shooting session,
- Disassemble it by removing the magazine cap, remove the barrel and clean everything in sight! Just follow the instructions given earlier in this manual. Use commonly available cleaning equipment, clean everything thoroughly light oil mechanism as well as the outside of the shotgun and your shotgun will last a lifetime.
- Keep your shotgun away from dust, acid and humidity.

## **SERVICE AND REPAIR**

Should your shotgun ever need service and repairs you may send it directly to your authorized repair station

## **WARRANTY**

- All the parts except wooden section have 3 years warranty.
- Maintenance and repair periods during warranty period will be added to the warranty period.
- The failure within 1 year from the initial sale date will be repaired by our company free of charge.
- This warranty will be valid if the customer performs his/her obligations completely according to the user's guide. Any failure arisen from misuse or improper use is not covered by this warranty.
- Our company undertakes to perform its warranty obligations under the circular numbered 90/41 - 42 issued by the Ministry of Trade published in the Official Gazette numbered 20464 and in case that we do not perform our obligations, we accept that the ministry of industry and trade is entitled to announce the situation to the public opinion.
- If any product repeats the same failure twice within warranty period or if its repair is not possible based on a report by our service, it will be replaced.
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
